All CEI students are guaranteed admission to ISU with successful completion of an Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Arts (AA) degree with a 2.0 or higher cumulative G.P.A.

HERE'S THE PLAN:

- **Year 1 & 2 : Attend the College of Eastern Idaho**
Spend your first two years primarily at the College of Eastern Idaho earning your associate's degree. We recommend meeting with an academic advisor early to choose the associate degree that best fits your long-term goals. Your advisor may recommend taking some ISU classes during this time based on your major and academic goals.
- **Year 3 & 4: Attend Idaho State University**
Upon completion of your CEI degree, you will move seamlessly to earn a Bachelor's degree at ISU!
