THE HIGHLIGHTS

- The survey included graduates from spring, summer and fall 2021 graduations
- Graduates were surveyed over a 6-month period, which conforms with the National Association of Colleges and Employers standard
- 78.8% of respondents are working or continuing their education within Idaho
- 65.1% of respondents who are continuing their education chose to attend ISU
- 51.3% of respondents participated in a Career Path Internship
- 68.9% of respondents believe their Career Path Internship was beneficial in their job search
- 72.1 % of respondents indicated they held a full-time or parttime position, internship, or volunteering experience while in college.


