



Mapping to the SSWC Faculty Hall Canon Printer

Windows 10

1. On the bottom left of your desktop, click on the Windows Start Menu icon.
2. Click on the gear icon to open up Windows Settings.
3. Click on the “Devices” tab.



4. Click on the “Printers & Scanners” tab.



5. Click on “Add a printer or scanner.”
6. Wait until the option “The printer that I want isn’t listed” appears, then click it.





8. Ensure that “Device type” is set to “IPP Device”.
9. For the “Hostname or IP address” field, enter in the following DNS name:

Canon MF269dw: **p_4_349_2.printer.isu.edu** or **10.255.0.20**



10. You should now see a window confirming the printer has been added.



11. Done! Feel free to print off a test page to confirm the process has completed successfully.
