

Legal Issues in Coaching and Sport Administration

Course Syllabus

Course Description/ Purpose

The purpose of this professional development course is to explore some of the many legal issues surrounding coaches and sport administrators in the school setting. This course will explore the law as it relates to sport in each of the following areas: Tort (including risk management planning and negligence), Constitutional protections, discrimination (including due process requirements and guidance related to drug testing athletes and also allowing religious prayer), Title IX, legal issues in athletic health care, emergency action planning, Safe Sport, and hiring considerations.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course you should be able to:

- 1. Understand the role and significance of "law" in coaching and sport administration.
- 2. Understand and appreciate the legal responsibility and roles of coaches to establish safe sports environments.
- 3. Ability to create an effective risk management plan for a sports program.
- 4. Understand how Constitutional protections apply to the sport setting, particularly as they relate to organized freedom of expression, prayer, due process, and drug testing.
- 5. Ability to understand and apply non-discriminatory practices in the sport setting.
- 6. Ability to understand and adhere to Federal Title IX regulations.
- 7. Understand the legal responsibilities involved with athletic health care and how to properly prepare for emergencies that might occur.
- 8. Understand the US Safe Sport Act requirements and gain guidance for hiring appropriately qualified coaches.
