

Student Teaching Observation Protocols

While student teaching, candidates shall have the following observations:

- 3 formal observations conducted by the University Supervisor
- 3 formal observations conducted by the Cooperating Teacher (same lessons)

FfT Formal Observation Protocol:

- 1. Candidate sends the lesson plan to their University Supervisor and/or Cooperating Teacher at least **3 days in advance**.
- 2. Candidate & University Supervisor/Cooperating Teacher meet for **pre-conference** at least 1 day in advance.
 - Discuss the lesson plan. Ask questions. Provide feedback. If any changes/additions are needed, let the candidate know.
 - Pre-conferences may be done in person, via videoconference, or via phone.
 - Submit lesson plan to CANVAS after making any advised changes
- 3. University Supervisor/Cooperating Teacher conducts a 30- to 60-minute observation, taking evidentiary notes.
- 4. University Supervisor/Cooperating Teacher completes the Danielson Domain 2 & 3 Observation Form. List evidence from notes in appropriate component comment areas. (Provide advice and/or opinions separately from evidence.)
- 5. Candidate and University Supervisor/Cooperating Teacher meet for a formal **post-conference**.
 - University Supervisor/Cooperating Teacher should guide the candidate in a professional conversation utilizing the evidence collected on the observation document, levels of performance, and discussion of strengths and growth opportunities.
 - Post-conferences may be done in person, via videoconference, or via phone.
- 6. University Supervisor and Cooperating Teacher provide the candidate a copy of the evaluation document.
- 7. Candidate submits documents to CANVAS with reflection.
