- Completion of the following prerequisite courses or equivalent with a grade of "C" or better: ENGL 1101 & 1102: PSYC 1101: NTD 2239 (Preferred) or 3340: BIOL 2227/2227L or BIOL 3301/3301L AND BIOL 2228/2228L or BIOL 3302/3302L: MATH (Goal 3) MATH 1153 preferred): COMM 1101: LLIB 1115.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 is required.
- Active unrestricted licensure to practice as an CNA in the State of Idaho
- Current CPR certification (Healthcare Provider) from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross.
- Current immunization and good health status per program policy, upon conditional acceptance into the program.
- Background check and drug screening per department policy, upon acceptance into the program.
