



 - Not employed due to lack of opportunity ($n = 1$, 8.3%)


Current Employment Status





 - Teaching, service, research. Teaching core, CMHC, and MCFC courses.




5. If employed as a counselor educator, please indicate what percentage (%) of time is spent across the following duties: Teaching ($M = 55.6\%$)




6. If employed as a counselor educator, please indicate what percentage (%) of time is spent across the following duties: Supervising ($M = 15.45\%$)

8. If employed as a counselor educator, please indicate what percentage (%) of time is spent across the following duties: Other ($M = 20.4\%$)








11. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to teach selected courses in the general CACREP common core.


12. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to teach selected courses in one or more of the CACREP major areas.




14. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to develop and conduct qualitative research.


15. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to write for professional publication


16. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to evaluate counselor education programs and counseling sites


17. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me to navigate professional issues in the field of counselor education, and the counseling profession.


18. The doctoral program at Idaho State University prepared me in the advisement and mentoring of master level counseling students.
