## MS in Nutrition with Dietetic Internship

Combine Your Degree and Supervised Practice



Beginning January 1, 2024, the minimum degree requirement for eligibility to take the registration examination to become a registered dietitian will be a graduate degree. This is in addition to post-baccalaureate supervised practice.

Our program at Idaho State University can be completed in 4 semesters and has:

- Combined your MS with your supervised practice
- 18 positions
- 3 locations- Pocatello, Meridian, and Twin Falls
- 1,200 hours of supervised practice
- 36 credits

## **Snapshot of ISU MS/Dietetic Internship**

Master of Science	<ul> <li>Combined Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetic Internship</li> <li>The MS/DI program is ACEND-approved</li> </ul>
Internship Components	<ul> <li>Community nutrition concentration; interns also rotate through clinical and food service sites</li> <li>Internship sites include medical centers, long-term care, health departments, local school districts, diabetes centers, dialysis centers, and out-patient clinics</li> </ul>
Number of Positions	<ul> <li>Eighteen (18) internship positions</li> <li>8 interns are place in Pocatello and surrounding areas</li> <li>2 interns complete rotations in Twin Falls and surrounding areas</li> <li>8 interns are based in Meridian/Treasure Valley and surrounding areas</li> </ul>
Internship Length	<ul> <li>16-month, 4-semester program – fall, spring, summer, fall</li> <li>Fall (Aug to Dec), Spring (Jan to May), Summer (May to Aug)</li> <li>In extreme circumstances an intern's timeframe may be extended up to 24 months (150% of the original 16-month plan)</li> </ul>
Weekly Time Requirements	<ul> <li>About 40 hours-per-week are spent in rotations; hours for coursework vary</li> <li>Travel time for practicums is not included (some rotations are 20-50 miles away)</li> <li>Interns are solely in coursework the first semester; interns will have a combination of coursework and practicum the final three semesters</li> <li>Hybrid coursework model (classes may require students to go to a distance learning classroom, access video conferencing software remotely, or work online as an autonomous, self-directed learner)</li> </ul>
Graduation and Program Completion Requirements	<ul> <li>Passing each semester requires completing all coursework with a grade of B (3.0 or higher) and finishing all rotations with at least a satisfactory grade (S)</li> <li>Interns earning at least an "S/B" in rotations/courses and completing a minimum of 1,200 hours of supervised practice receive a Master of Science in Nutrition and a Dietetic Internship Verification Statement</li> <li>Graduates are eligible to sit for the national registration exam</li> </ul>
