By the end of the course, participants will be equipped with the knowledge and skills to create inclusive, supportive, and positive learning environments through the implementation of PBIS principles.

This course enhances classroom teaching effectiveness and supports improved student outcomes by introducing new knowledge in Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), equipping educators with strategies to foster positive behavior, implement tiered interventions, utilize data for decision-making, and engage families in creating inclusive school environments.

7. Understand Tier 3 support within PBIS, focusing on its essential systems and practices to effectively deliver individualized interventions and improve academic and behavioral success.
8. Explore strategies for involving families in the PBIS process to create a collaborative and supportive environment.
