Course Syllabus

Course Description

This course focuses on first understanding the struggles that today's students face and how they impact learning in the classroom. Secondly, it focuses on understanding how to create a positive learning environment and its importance. This course helps educators form positive relationships with students, parents, and community members. Educators will also learn about the importance of these relationships as they correlate to student success. By the end of this course, educators will have several strategies that will help them form and maintain positive relationships with all stakeholders.

This course enhances classroom teaching effectiveness and supports improved student outcomes by introducing new knowledge in positive relationship building: how to create positive learning environments and build strong, supportive relationships with students, parents, and community members to enhance student success.

- 6. Identify strategies for maintaining positive relationships with students, parents, and community members.
