

Improving Classroom Management: Creating Inclusive, Positive, and Effective Learning Environments

Course Syllabus

Course Description

The purpose of this professional development course is to equip educators with the essential tools and strategies to add to an existing classroom management plan, including SEL and inclusion strategies. Each of the tools we look at in this course will help to create a positive and conducive learning environment for students. This course includes instruction into possible triggers of undesired behaviors and how to address those in typical and neurotypical students. Through a series of 8 modules, participants will explore key components such as social-emotional learning, inclusive practices, positive communication, and empathy, all of which are integral to fostering a supportive classroom community.

This course enhances classroom teaching effectiveness and supports improved student outcomes by introducing new knowledge in classroom management, inclusive practices, and social-emotional learning strategies for elementary educators.

Course Objectives

- 1. Recognize the importance of classroom management.
- 2. Describe how to set up a positive classroom environment.
- 3. Identify strategies to develop and teach age-appropriate rules and procedures.
- 4. Describe triggers for inappropriate behavior and how you can address those behaviors with effective strategies.
- 5. Demonstrate how to create inclusive classroom environments for neurodiverse students.
- 6. Demonstrate the ability to seamlessly integrate Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) principles into daily curriculum and activities for elementary students.
- 7. Identify strategies to communicate with parents and students.
- 8. Identify ways to enhance your classroom management through reflective practice and educator wellness.
