



Understanding and Managing Disruptive Behaviors in the Classroom

Course Syllabus

Course Description

This course will help you to understand external factors that often impact student behavior in the classroom. Understanding the 'why' behind the misbehavior will strengthen you as the educator and address disruptive behavior in the classroom. Modern strategies for managing disruptive behavior will be discussed, including Positive Behavior Intervention Systems, Social Emotional Learning, and identifying school-based resources for educators as well as students.

This course enhances classroom teaching effectiveness and supports improved student outcomes by introducing new knowledge in managing disruptive student behavior through understanding external influences, implementing Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS), and integrating Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) strategies.

Course Objectives

2. Understand and identify 10 recent trends in student behavior.
3. Identify 10 common disruptive behaviors and analyze their impact in the classroom.

6. Identify Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS) components and how they can aid your classroom.
7. Understand 5 core aspects of Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) and 10 ways to implement SEL in your classroom.
8. Identify 5 classroom management strategies, 5 resources and 5 people in your school who can help you manage disruptive behaviors.
