SUGGESTED COURSE SEQUENCE FOR B.M.E. DEGREE

- (R) = Classes that meet on an alternating year rotation. If you miss/fail one of these classes, you may not be able to take it again for THREE semesters.
- (S) = Classes that are traditionally offered during the summer. Taking these during the summer may give you more flexibility, less workload, and could reduce the number of semesters needed to graduate.
- *The Piano Proficiency Requirement must be met. If a student cannot pass the proficiency exam, he/she must take Class Piano (1118-1119 or 2218-2219) courses at the appropriate level until MUSC 2219 is passed with a "C-" or better. Students must register concurrently for Class Piano with MUSC 1103-1104 and 2203-2204.
- ** Senior Recital. Students are expected to participate in chamber ensembles during their degree program. A chamber work is required on the senior recital. Students may sign up for optional credit, but you must do a FULL RECITAL for 2 credits.
- *** **Objectives:** You must take 36 credits of Approved Objective courses to graduate (see the undergraduate catalog for approved courses). Vocal BME Majors are encouraged to Foreign Language to complete Objective 4 and the completion of the 36 total credits.

Admission to the Teacher Education Program

Students must apply for admission to the Teacher Education Program. All MUSIC and EDUCATION coursework must be a grade of C (2.0) or higher. Minimum GPA for entrance into the Teacher Ed Program is 3.0.

Application forms are available in the Student Academic Advising Center of the College of Education (COE). Students may not register for Education courses numbered 3000 and above until full admittance to the Teacher Education Program in the COE is achieved. Music Education majors should apply for admission as soon as possible to be eligible for COE SCHOLARSHIPS. Specific requirements for admission are available in the ISU Undergraduate Catalog, the COE Website, or at KentCenter@isu.edu. Applications are accepted year round.

Application for Student Teaching: Students must also apply for student teaching ONE YEAR before they student teach. Students must have Praxis II Scores and have completed all previous coursework. Applications are due in October/April.
