Revised 2015 **\*The Piano Proficiency Requirement must be met.** If a student cannot pass the proficiency exam, he/she must take Class Piano (1118-1119 or 2218-2219) courses at the appropriate level until MUSC 2219 is passed with a "C-" or better. Students must register concurrently for Class Piano with MUSC 1103-1104 and 2203-2204.

**\*\*Electives**. ISU requires that 36 of the credits counted toward graduation must be in upper division courses carrying 3000 or 4000 numbers. Sixteen of these credits must be earned in music courses. Therefore, some non-music elective courses will need to be at the upper division level in order to satisfy ISU graduation requirements. Music electives must be chosen from Music Courses, not from Applied Music or Music Ensembles (Performing Organizations).

**\*\*\*Senior Recital.** Students are expected to participate in chamber ensembles during their degree program. A chamber work is required on the senior recital.
