

LEARNING GOALS AND OUTCOMES FOR SOWK 3373 - Group Work

Course Description

This course will examine mezzo level systems within the generalist social work framework. Group theory, process, dynamics and their application to practice will be covered. Students will utilize a generalist skill base in learning to engage, assess, intervene, and evaluate with small group systems.
