

New Club Funding









NEW CLUB FUNDING



- Club must be registered.
- At least one officer must ...
 - attend the Financial Workshop.
 - attend the New Officer Training.
 - o attend C.E.A.S.A.R. Training.
 - attend Club Advisor Training.
 - attend one ASISU Senate meeting.
- If the club is formed after workshops are held, officers may instead schedule time with the office of Student Leadership & Engagement.



Restrictions

- Clubs may apply for funding only through the end of the semester following the semester in which they were organized (or reorganized after a year of inactivity).
- Clubs may apply for a maximum of \$500.
- Clubs may not receive both new club funding and the initial deposit in the same semester.



Do's

- Fill out the budget template completely before submitting.
- Submit at least 5 weeks before your event to allow for processing.
- Turn in your application by Thursday at 5:00 PM to be on the Finance Committee's agenda the following week.
- Attend Finance Committee and Senate meetings related to your request so questions can be answered and updates received once your receive confirmation from the Director of Finance.

Don'ts


- Don't submit an incomplete budget template it won't be considered.
- Don't plan to use funds for an event happening within the 5week processing period — your application will be voided.
- Don't expect reimbursement for events that already happened
 retroactive funding is not allowed.
- Don't skip meetings absence could delay or affect your funding approval.
