UReCA Seeking Student Editors

UReCA, the NCHC Journal of Undergraduate Research and Creative Activity is now accepting applications for editorial positions with the journal.

In order to apply, students must be pursuing their undergraduate degrees and be enrolled in an honors program or college that is a member of NCHC. The strongest of applicants will have relevant research or editorial experience and will demonstrate sufficient knowledge relevant to their field of study. Those students who are selected will serve for the duration of one academic year with the opportunity to return upon invitation.

Editors must be able to attend a three-day editorial workshop to be held in Dillon, Montana, during the first week of June. The deadline is March 01, 2024.
