Curriculum, Course, and Program Change Proposals:

1. [Proposal #15](#) from COSE **Computer Science** to update CS courses prerequisites, create new CS 1111 as Obj 7 Gen Ed course, new CS 2281 to replace CS 2235 being deleted, update CS curriculum and teaching endorsement. *Changes affect Graduate Catalog. GERC approved CS 1111 as new Obj 7 Gen Ed course. Requires Letter of Notification #[2024-LON-07](#) notifying OSBE, and NWCCU approval of curricular and credit changes.*
2. [Proposal #22](#) from COSE **Nuclear Engineering** to change MATH 3360 from required co-requisite to pre/co-requisite for NE 3302.
3. [Proposal #32](#) from CAL and Student Success Center **University Honors Program** to create a new 9-credit Certificate in Civic Engagement open to students in the Honors program and participating as a mentored volunteer in a chosen partner organization. *Requires Letter of Notification #[2024-LON-08](#) notifying OSBE, and NWCCU approval of the new certificate.*
4. [Proposal #35](#) from COH **Communication Sciences & Disorders** to eliminate summer offerings for CSD 4420 & CSD 4460, and eliminate both courses from required curriculum for the Pre-Professional Certificate in Pre-Speech-Language Pathology, thereby reducing the total credits required from 36 down to 31 credits. *Changes affect Graduate Catalog. Requires Letter of Notification #[2024-LON-09](#) notifying OSBE, and NWCCU approval of curricular and credit changes.*
